### Library Computers

The library has seventeen computers available for public access, all located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. There is no charge for computer use.

- 7 30-minute computers running Windows (require sign-up)
- 7 30-minute computers running as Macs (require sign-up)
- 4 Windows 15 minute 'Quick Check' computers

All computers allow printing in black and white for 10 cents per page

Available computer resources include:

- Internet Browsing
- Microsoft Word
- Microsoft Excel
- Microsoft PowerPoint
- Gimp photo editing software
- CD Burning capability
- SD Card Reader
- USB Interface for portable hard drives, flash drives or cameras
- Headphones



### Wireless Internet Access

Library patrons who wish to access the Internet from their own computers may connect to the wireless network 'Estes Library'. There is no password but users who attach to the network must then open their Internet browser software and agree to the library's terms of usage before they will be able to use the network. Printing is not available from personal machines. There is no charge for wireless access.



### Closing Time

The second floor of the library closes 15 minutes before the rest of the facility. Both library computers and the wireless network will become unavailable when the second floor closes. Wireless access will become available again when the library closes and can often be accessed from outside the building.

Library patrons are warned that both wireless and library computer users are accessing a non-secure public network. All data is vulnerable to access by others. Guard your information by not working with material that is confidential on any public network.
